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### 1-Lean on Me for Growth

#### Icebreaker: Grits

There is no such thing as a single grit. Grits don't exist alone. Discuss how people are like grits. Even though some people are grittier than others, God intends us to be in community with others.

#### Questions for Study or Discussion

- When we exhort one another, it helps us grow (Acts 2:40).
  Exhorting is more than encouraging. Discuss times when someone exhorted you in the following ways:
  - Urged you to follow God's Word
  - Comforted you when you struggled
  - ▶ Confronted you when you went against God's Word
  - ▶ Encouraged you when you took a risk for God
- Fellowship is more than social events. It is sharing our spiritual lives with others (Acts 2:42). What are the benefits of sharing our spiritual lives?
  - ▶ Proverbs 27:17
  - ▶ Psalm 133:1
  - Hebrews 3:13

What opportunities do you have for sharing your spiritual lives with others?

In what ways are two better than one (Ecc 4:9-12)?

## Dig a Little Deeper: My Brother's Keeper

- You are your brother's keeper (Gen 4:9). Keeper = shamar (Hebrew for guard, protect, attend). Who in your life do you guard and protect?
- You need others and they need you (1The 2:7). What have others done to guard and protect you?

- Encourage someone in his/her walk with God.

## 2-Lean on Me for Love

#### Icebreaker: Because He First Loved Us

We love Him because He first loved us [1John 4:19-21]. In what way can we love others before they love us?

# Questions for Study or Discussion

- Fellowship is more than social events. It is showing love for one another (Acts 2:42). What are small ways to express your love for others?
- When it comes to love, why do our actions speak louder than words [1John 3:18]?
- How is bearing one another's burdens an act of love (Rom 15:1-6)?
- How is serving one another an act of love (Gal 5:13)? Make a list of ways to serve one another.

- To nurture another person, you must share part of yourself
  (1The 2:8). Make a list of ways to share part of yourself with others.
- Which of the following are you most likely to do to express your love for other people?
  - Tell them how dear they are to you.
  - Give them a hug.
  - Do something nice for them.
  - Spend quality time with them.
- God wants us to spur one another on toward love and good deeds (Heb 10:24-25).
  - ▶ Who encourages you to express Christ's love to others?
  - ▶ Who do you encourage to reflect Christ's love?
