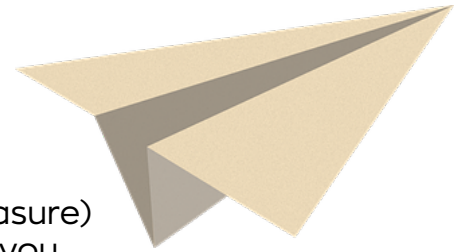

Read *Isaiah 6:5-8*. If you saw the Lord on His Throne, you would respond as Isaiah did, “Woe is me!” You would know that everything you have (talents, time, treasure) are from Him. You would know that He gave those things to you for a reason.

If the Lord asked, “Whom shall I send...?” would you respond as Isaiah did, “Here am I! Send me”?
