Accept Christ's Purpose

Since Christ arrived on Earth, there has been confusion about and resistance to Christ's purpose.

During Jesus' Ministry

- What the Jewish believers expected was a Messiah who would rescue them from their oppressors. When the angel announced the coming of Jesus, it was clear that His purpose was to deliver them from their sins, not their oppressors, **Mat 1:21**.
- Jesus was more than a miracle maker. He did not commit Himself to those who focused only on the miracles, **John 2:23-25**.
- Some people were interested in Him feeding and healing them physically. They believed who Jesus was, but did not accept His purpose. They weren't true Christ-followers. He warned them that He would say that He never knew them, **Mat 7:21-23**.

Today

- Today, many of those who believe in Christ mistakenly see Him from the viewpoint of their desires rather than as He truly is, **John 8:30**.
- Rejection of Christ's purpose is still common today.
 - False teachers encourage people to believe in Jesus for the wrong reasons **Acts 20:29-30, 2Pet 2:1-3**.
 - They focus on assorted people's "rights" instead of their need for saving from sin.
 - False teachers rally large groups who say they are Christians, but don't understand or accept the true gospel. They aren't convicted of sin, **John 16:8, Acts 20:21**.
 - Some of those claiming to be Christians are joining forces with others to uphold "traditional" values, but they fail to focus on saving people from sin.

Christ came to call sinners to repentance, **Luke 5:32**.

Do you accept His stated purpose?

Are you a true Christ-follower?
