In the account of the Transfiguration ([Mat 17:1-13](#)), Jesus selected a private place. This pictures our need to withdraw from our regular activities to experience a transforming fellowship with God.



When burdened with cares of the world, it is difficult to lift up our hearts and seek spiritual things. How often do you schedule times of retreat to be alone with God and His Word? Here are some reasons it is important to have regular times alone with God:

- It lets God know how important He is to you ([Mat 6:33](#)).

- It fills you so that you can pour yourself out for others ([1Cor 10:23-24](#)).
